

Our School

Duisburg Night School (WBK Duisburg) is a second chance school for adult students (18 years +) who wish to obtain higher school certificates and degrees. It is run by the state so there are no teaching fees. Most books and materials are provided by the school free of charge.

In class students of different age, origin etc. learn and study together for their individual goals like better job chances, entrance to university or further education.

For maximum flexibility we offer traditional in-class teaching in both Abendrealschule and Abendgymnasium programs on four evenings (Mondays to Thursdays 5.20pm – 10.00pm).

Additionally we offer abitur-online.nrw in Abendgymnasium for more individual organisation combining two evenings of in-class teaching (Monday and Tuesday) with self-study periods to be structured by the students according to their individual job, family etc. situation.

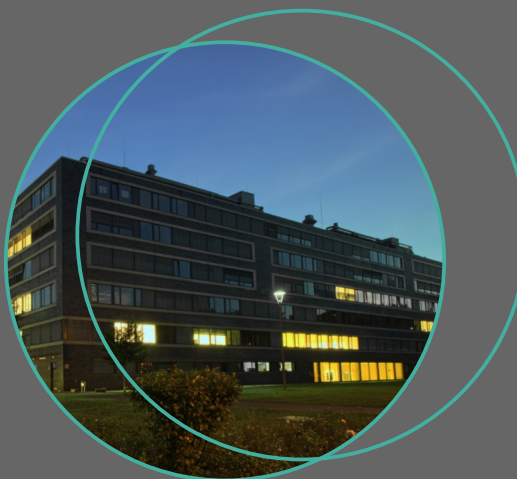
All classes start after the summer holidays in August every year with additional Abendrealschul classes beginning each February.

(Fachabitur schulischer Teil, Abitur)

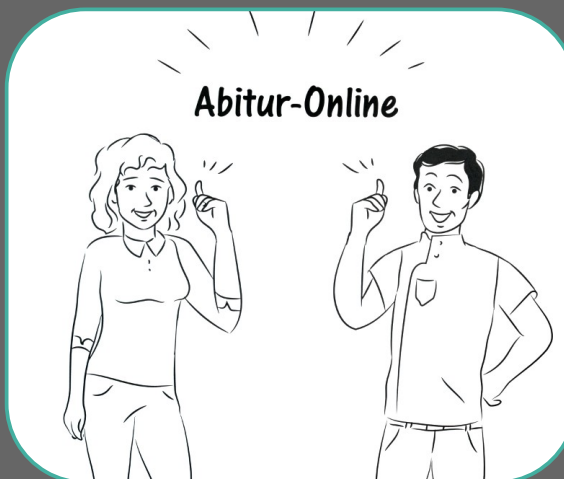
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abitur-online.nrw combines web-based remote learning and traditional in-classroom teaching. Classes take place on two nights at school (Monday and Tuesday, 5.20pm – 10:00pm), while self-studying is organized on a platform providing virtual classrooms for communication purposes and tasks and materials. There's an introduction on how to work with the platform at the beginning of the course.

Tests and exams mostly take place on classroom learning days with extra dates announced in advance. Work and assignments done at home are part of your oral marks.

Students can organize their self-study periods according to their individual time slots.



Requirements

- completed compulsory school attendance
- Abendrealschule: six months of employment, or employment at time of school attendance
- Abendgymnasium: completed apprenticeship, or two years of employment
